



The International Student Scholarship Program

THE PROGRAM

The International Student Scholarship Program is designed to make a quality college education accessible to International students and to mentor them to help prepare them to be the hands and feet of Jesus in their community. Applicants must be pursuing full-time studies at Esperanza College.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants of the International Student Scholarship Program must:

- Be an International student as defined by Esperanza College
- Be involved in leadership activities in their community or demonstrate the potential to be a leader in their community
- Be a current enrolled student at Esperanza College or be accepted for full-time study in the following semester
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Enroll in a payment plan agreement
- Continue to study consecutively through an academic year
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale while enrolled at Esperanza College

AWARDS

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award that will ensure a cost to the student of no more than \$5,000 per academic year towards tuition. Up to 10 awards will be granted annually. Awards will not exceed the total costs of tuition, fees, books, and supplies.

APPLICATION

Applications will be open for the following semester on February 1 (for Fall) and August 1 (for Spring). Applicants are encouraged to apply as soon as possible but no later than May 1 for the Fall semester or Oct 15 for the Spring semester. Interested students must complete the application and submit it along with an official academic transcript, a resume, and letter of recommendation to the Student Service Finance Office no later than May 1st for the fall semester and October 15th for spring semester. Applicants will receive acknowledgment of receipt of their application. If an acknowledgment email is not received within one week, applicants may call the Student Service Finance Office to verify the application was received.



Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, all questions must be answered as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by the Student Service Finance Office.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The Esperanza College Student Financial Services Office processes scholarship payments directly with Eastern University's Financial Aid Office.

OBLIGATIONS

Recipients have an obligation to meet Student Academic Progress guidelines and maintain the minimum required cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must submit transcripts at the end of each awarded semester. Recipients must also provide 50 hours of service to either the Office of the President or Esperanza College during the current academic year. Additionally, recipients are required to notify the Student Financial Services Office of any changes in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information. If for any reason a recipient must take a leave of absence or withdraw from Esperanza College the scholarship is then forfeited.

REVISIONS

Esperanza College reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.
